A mosaic representing mobility (모자이크 타일 시공 - 벽화)



On the occasion of the 1,000 year anniversary the city of Fuerth made itself a gift - a large and colourful wall mosaic created by the artist Iris Rauh who domiciles in the city. The unique artwork with the title "Local traffic in the changing times – from the eagle to the underground railway" decorates a wall of the underground railway station Jakobinenstrasse.

The mural – approx. 10 metres long with a total size of approx. 31 sqm - was pieced together in handcraft work by the mosaic artist Iris Rauh and her team - out of about 800,000 mosaic pieces broken from tiles by hand.

„Where old pavement feels good“ (보도 포장)



Meißen, the “cradle of Saxony”, attracts thousands of tourists year after year visiting the numerous places of interest of the city. It requires solid and safe paths to be able to reach these attractions of Meißen.

Traffic in the old town of Meißen rolls over historical granite slabs and pavement surfaces without any exception. The footpaths are mainly build of granite slabs in combination with small sett pavers, on roads and places you mostly find large sett pavers made of red Meißen granite or other hard stone from the immediate vicinity.

Preservation and renovation measures are carried out on a continuous basis. The rehabilitation measures are not only limited to the traffic areas, supply lines and waste disposal lines lying underneath the traffic areas are involved as well. Quite often it is the ramschackle substrate which forces to act just like in case of the alley Marktgasse, one of the arterial roads for foot and supply traffic in the old town.

Waterproofing and tiling at the Spa Bad Wörishofen (온천 시공)



The thermal water of the Bad Wörishofen spa rises from a depth of 1,100 metres and runs into the pools of the new spa which opened in May 2004 after a construction time of only 11 months. Due to the especially rich composition (brine, fluoride, iodine) it is state-approved as thermal water and is recommended e.g. to relieve disease of the locomotor system or to rehabilitate after operations of the links.

Creating a snake-skin "Nano-light" (모자이크 타일 시공)



A magical snake winds through the grounds of the National Garden Festival 2004 in Burghausen which opened the end of April. The reptile's body was created in September 2003 and the design of its snake-skin was done with ease by creative kindergarten kids supported by their parents and teachers. In view of the grey, unprepared concrete surface the little artists were very anxious to create a colourful and shiny mosaic skin from many small tile pieces. PCI Augsburg donated the tile adhesive and joint grout. The new multi-use flexible mortar PCI Nanolight was applied here and could proof once again its multi-purpose qualities also on this special substrate.

Floor tiles made of natural stone in the MAC Main-Airport-Center at the Frankfurt a.M. airport

(공항 자연석 바닥 시공)



In the middle of the junction of national and international traffic lines the Main-Airport-Center is located directly across the Frankfurt airport. If by road, rail or air – from here you can reach all places in the world in no time. For this reason the MAC gave itself the title "fastest office of Germany". The general contractor Wayss & Freytag built the ten-storied new building with a gross floor area of about 75,000 sqm in only two and a half years.

The streamlined appearance of the building and the very flexible interior concept reflect the speed as a central architectural topic.

This topic even reflected in the accomplishment phase. An anhydrite flowable screed with integrated underfloor heating was chosen as a substrate for the different floorings – among other reasons due to the high performance of large areas and the early walkability.

The calcium sulphate flowable screed substrates in both two-storied entrance halls were covered with travertine natural stone tiles, format 150 x 60 x 4 cm.

On July 17 the doors opened to the spa "Wonnemar" at the health resort Bad Liebenwerda (south Brandenburg). After a construction time of 18 months and costs of 30.7 million EUR a spa covering 39,000 sqm was created which will not be found anywhere in Germany so soon again. In comparison to the existing "Wonnemar" spas in Wismar, Sonthofen and Ingolstadt this one is the largest with the most comprehensive healthcare and wellness area. The project combines the areas adventure world, mineral forum, therapy and sauna world on 4 storeys and the visitor can enjoy fun splash and wellness in the noble interiors and exteriors. 17 different pools inside with a water area of 1,100 sqm and another 5 pools outside with an area of 456 sqm are available to the visitor. Four slides for more or less venturous people complement the fun world. The mineral forum – and especially the variety of applications in the therapy area and the sauna world – concentrate on supporting and maintaining your health in a partially oriental or mediterranean atmosphere.

Art comes from skill. No matter whether it is about international artists or hobby artists. The skill, the quality of the artist is what it is all about. This is the way the creative tiler Elmar Groß from Nalbach-Bilsdorf looks at it. He has renovated the façade of his town house last year. The aim was to give the façade an artistic look and to put up a thermal insulation at the same time.

The tiling works at the façade were done with the multi-use flexible mortar PCI Nanolight which can be applied without any problems to all ceramic coverings on all kinds of substrates – in interiors as well as exteriors.

Grouting was done with PCI Aquafug, an ultra-fine joint grout which is repellent to water and resistant to frost.

Germany's largest market place awakes to new, joyful life (화강암 바닥 시공) (화강암 바닥 시공)

Freudenstadt, located in Germany's beautiful black forest region, is the oldest symmetrical urban installation north of the Alps. Four hundred years ago it was precisely planned on a drawing board by the renowned Swabian architect Heinrich Schickhardt in the Italian late renaissance style. For Duke Friedrich von Württemberg, Schickhardt built three rows of houses, arranged like a chessboard, the innermost one with arcades, around a huge place measuring 225 meters in length.



A fourth row of houses was added following the immigration of religious refugees from the Steiermark and Kärnten regions. Since the planned castle was never realized on the wide open space, the area remained free and became Germany's largest market place. Just in time for the city anniversary, the place was now renovated and improved with new granite slabs. The following PCI materials were used:
